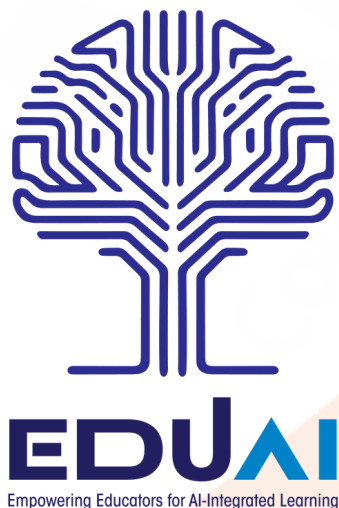

Final International Conference and Transnational Project Meeting



The final transnational meeting of the CarboNostrum Project, held at Clube Fluvial Odemirense in Odemira, with the generous support of Município de Odemira, on May 27th and 29th.

During a pivotal meeting, the CarboNostrum project team finalized preparations for the Final International Conference held on May 28th. They reflected on significant milestones, including the completion of the Manual and Case Studies, the CarboNostrum Blended Course, and the WebGIS platform. The team also planned next steps, such as organizing workshops and multiplier events in partner countries.



The Final conference, held on the 28th of May, at Cineteatro Camacho Costa in Odemira, Portugal, was a resounding success with around 65 people involved in Agriculture. 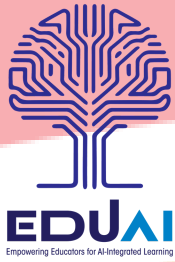
Training Highlights:

- **Filmmaking Techniques:** Participants learned how to capture engaging content through effective filmmaking techniques.
- **Podcast Production:** Training on creating podcasts and conducting insightful interviews.
- **Video Editing Skills:** Mastered video editing using DaVinci Resolve to produce polished, professional videos.

Practical Skills Acquired:

- **Camera and Microphone Control:** Techniques for managing cameras and microphones to ensure high-quality recordings.
- **Light and Sound Management:** Strategies for controlling light and sound to create the perfect shot.
- **On-the-Spot Content Creation:** Practical exercises using cameras and sound recorders to create content in real-time.
- **Editing Mastery:** Bringing projects to life by turning raw footage and recordings into polished documentaries and podcasts.

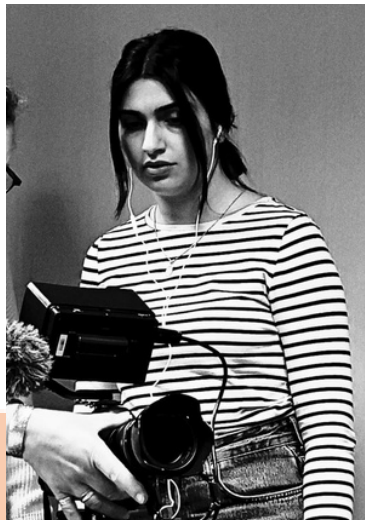
We expect that these workshop helps all partners with the project future steps: doing documentaries and podcasts.

Training “WORKING AT HEIGHT”

Within the scope of our Professional Training offer, it was held on the 22nd and 23rd of June the Working at Height course, with a duration of 16 hours; this course was taught by the trainers Bruno Canha and Vítor Canha.

This training course, aimed at workers who are responsible for carrying out work at height using ropes, aimed to provide trainees with skills in working at height. With a theoretical methodology in the classroom, case study presentation and demonstration in the practical component. Teamwork was encouraged, providing preventive and corrective measures for carrying out work at height using ropes, in order to reduce and/or eliminate accidents.
