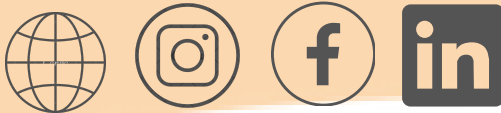

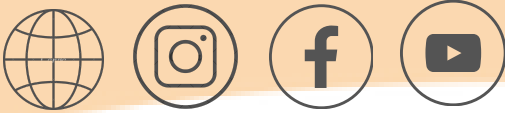

Gain Kids Project – Global Citizenship Action at the Portuguese School in Cape Verde

In June, in collaboration with the Maria Borges de Medeiros Training Centre, we carried out a Short-Term Action (ACD) at the Portuguese School in Cape Verde (EPCV). This activity, led by trainer Marisol Carmelino, aimed to promote Global Citizenship in pre-school education, through the GAINKids project, developed by AidLearn together with other partners, within the scope of the Erasmus+ programme.

This project promotes Global Citizenship in pre-school, based on the Convention on the Rights of the Child. Through a three-dimensional approach, it encourages actions with children, trains teachers and raises awareness among families, addressing topics such as Equal Opportunities, Non-Discrimination, Gender Equality and Diversity. The project culminates in the creation of a Pedagogical Kit, with the active participation of children in its preparation. During the event, two collections of books were donated to the EPCV library. The remaining materials are available on the website in five languages. The Educational Kit contains a collection of five stories for children, a Practical Guide for educators and an informative brochure for families.

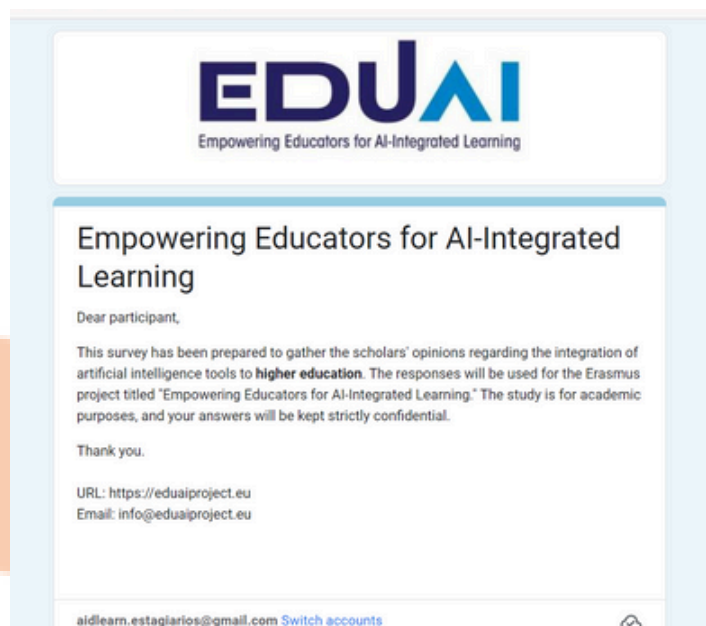


EduAI Project Survey Release

In today's digital age, it is crucial to enhance cybersecurity awareness and encourage responsible digital consumption in order to navigate the complexities of the internet safely. By implementing educational initiatives, leveraging technological advancements, and fostering a culture of collaboration around security, individuals and organisations can strengthen their defences against the increasing wave of cyber threats.

Here are some Cybersecurity threats you should know:

- **Malware:** Malicious software like viruses, worms, and ransomware aim to harm or steal data.
- **Phishing:** Fake emails or websites trick you into sharing sensitive info.
- **Ransomware:** Your files get locked, and hackers demand payment to restore access.
- **Insider Threats:** Risks from within—employees or contractors can accidentally or intentionally leak data.
- **Advanced Persistent Threats (APTs):** Long-term, targeted attacks from organized cyber criminals or nations, aiming for espionage or sabotage.

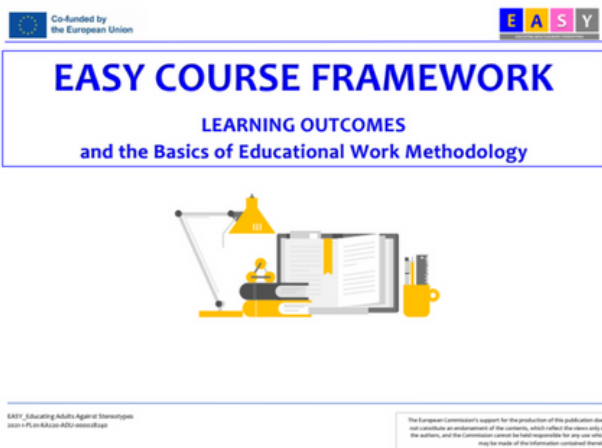

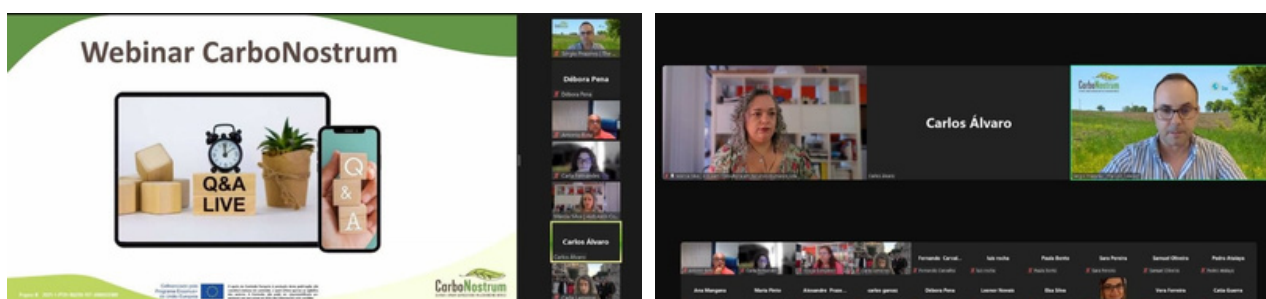

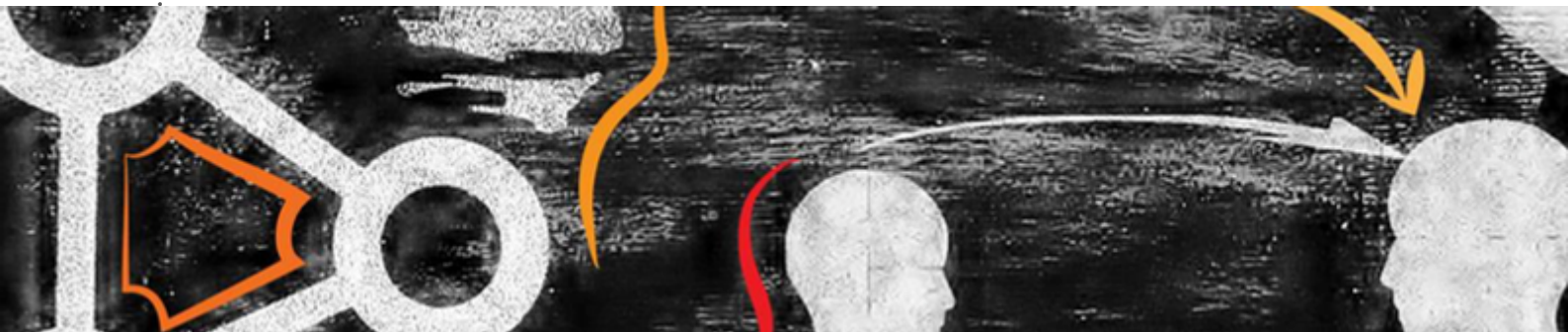
